Date Issued: 17 Sep 2025

Validity Period: 21 – 22 September 2025

Location: Badhaadhe District and surrounding areas, Lower Juba Region

(Message begins)

Current Situation: Forecasts from NOAA-GFS indicate a **westward-moving weather system** that is likely to bring **very intense rainfall on Monday, 22 September 2025** over Badhaadhe District. Light rains are expected in Kismaayo District (Lower Juba), Awdal Region (Somaliland), Laasqoray District (Sanaag), and northern Bari, with dry conditions elsewhere

Possible Impacts

- Flash floods in Badhaadhe may lead to dangerous run-off, washing away roads, low-lying settlements, and crops
- Potential damage to boreholes, shallow wells, and sanitation facilities, increasing water-borne disease risk

Recommended Actions

Community and local authorities:

- Stay away from seasonal rivers, wadis, and low-lying bridges during heavy rain
- Pre-position emergency supplies and move livestock and essential household items to higher ground
- Avoid night travel and do not attempt to cross flooded roads

Stay informed:

- Follow updates from FAO-SWALIM and SoDMA through local radio, television, and SMS alerts
