
Rainfall Forecast Somalia Issued: 03/05/2016

Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations

Widespread rains are expected across Somalia in the next three days. The northern regions of the country are expected to receive moderate to high rains, while in the central and southern regions the forecast points towards light to moderate rains.

The upper catchments of the Juba and Shabelle rivers are also expected to receive moderate to high rains within the same period. The river levels remain high in both Juba and Shabelle, with **high** risk of flooding along the Middle and Lower Shabelle; while in Middle and Lower Juba the risk of flooding is <u>moderate</u>.
